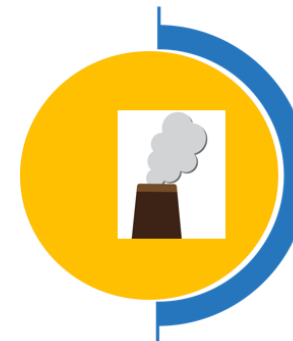

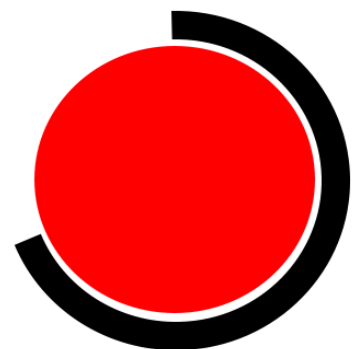

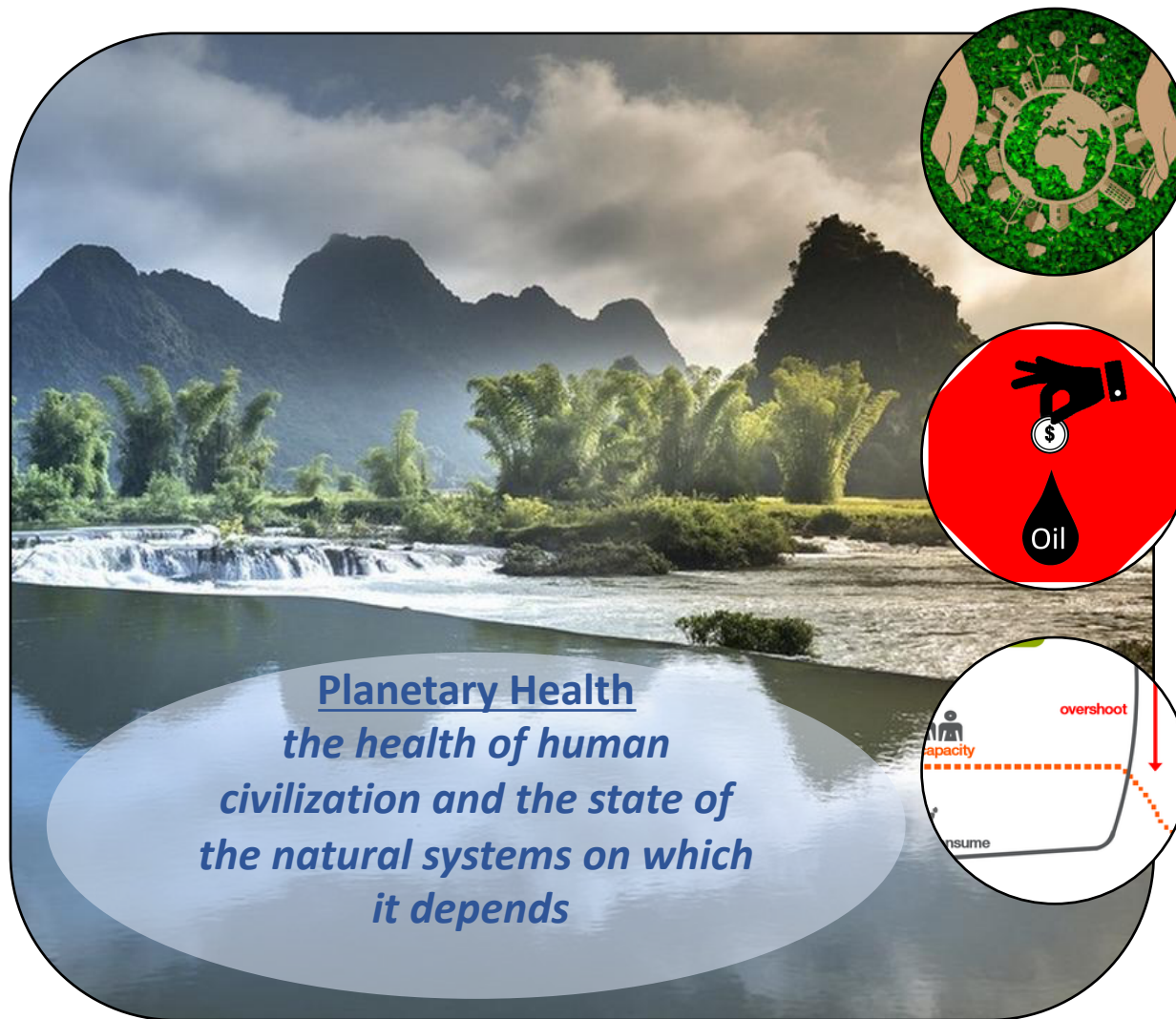

to frame finance policies**

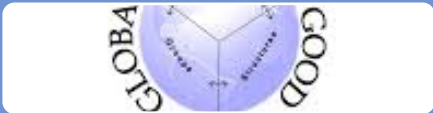
